

Our activity was down 11% for 2011 which followed a county wide trend with all agencies the communications center dispatches for having reduced activity. Due to deputies' efforts in community policing, being proactive with preventing crimes in our county, and providing aggressive enforcement in problem areas we have increased the chances of quick and early detection of issues. Our email tip line continues to provide us with vital information regarding ongoing investigations as well.


TOTAL CALLS HANDLED BY COMMUNICATIONS





PARK COUNTY DETENTION CENTER

The Park County Detention Center also tracks the use of force incidents against inmates within our care and protection. These incidents are tracked whenever a detention deputy has to utilize force against a non-compliant inmate. This can be in the form of a compliance hold such as a wrist-lock up to the use of a Taser or pepper spray. We strive to keep this number as low as possible by providing the best training to our deputies in ways to mitigate the situation utilizing the resources and training provided to them.

2007: 6 incidents required the use of force to gain compliance.
2008: 10 incidents required the use of force to gain compliance.
2009: 6 incidents required the use of force to gain compliance.
2010: 12 incidents required the use of force to gain compliance.
2011: 13 incidents required the use of force to gain compliance.

Assaults by inmates against each other and officers decreased in 2011. We continually strive to reduce this number to zero. All inmates who assault another inmate and or officer are prosecuted under Wyoming State Statute.
